Footnotes

MCGILL broke sharply and pressed the early pace racing one from the rail, dueled for the lead from the outside of JJ'S ORCHID entering the stretch and wore that rival down while closing three wide. J J'S ORCHID away alertly and took command from the onset while racing along the rail, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to match strides with MCGILL in deep stretch. REMARKABLY FREE stalked the early pacesetters while saving ground at the rail, tipped four wide into the stretch and was gaining late. EPICUREAN unhurried early and saved ground at the rail through the first turn, was bumped repeatedly by UPPER CRUST down the backstretch, advanced along the inside on the final turn and closed five wide in the stretch. UPPER CRUST chased four wide into the first turn, bumped with a rival to her inside repeatedly upon entering the backstretch, posted a mild bid nearing the final turn but weakened in the final furlong. TRICKSY away well and chased the early leaders into the first turn racing three wide, held a striking position down the backside but faded in the late stages.
