Footnotes

TAYLORS DEAL stalked the early leaders while saving ground along the rail through the second turn, tipped off the rail mid way down the backstretch, engaged the leaders three wide entering the final turn and quickly took command and drew clear. WILO KAT stalked the pace into the second turn racing three wide, dropped back entering the backstretch, rallied four wide through the final turn, and closed gamely through the stretch to get up for the place. HIGH END MAN vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, was collared by TAYLORS DEAL entering the final turn, and just failed to last for the place. SHINTOISM allowed to settle through the early going racing one from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn, was forced to steady briefly mid way through the turn when impeded slightly, and finished well through the lane. ALBERTA BREEZE allowed to settle off the leaders entering the first turn, saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, but needed more of a closing response when called upon. DEPUTY'S COMMAND unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide through the final turn and improved his position without ever threatening. BRASS AND GOLD showed no early speed while racing one from the rail, but was never a factor. UNQUIET dueled one from the rail from the onset, pressed the issue into the final turn before weakening. SIMON TEMPLAR stalked the leaders into the backstretch racing out from the rail, but faded in the final furlong. TIMELESS STORM pressed the pace three wide into the first turn before dropping back into a tracking position one from the rail through the stretch the first time, began to drop back approaching the final turn and tired.
