NAKODA away alertly, had good position, stalked the pace and weakened. ADDY'S HOEDOWN unhurried early, stalked the pace and went evenly. KATALINA FLIGHT unhurried early, was three wide on the first turn and showed little. AMERICAN MARKET away alertly, well placed, was through early and gave way. THE KAT'S WHISKERS away alertly, was in tight and had to be taken up into the first turn, was through after a half. CATAHOULA ROSE slow early, trailed and showed little.
