### Footnotes

KID KATABATIC off slowly, trailed, rallied between horses on the final turn, three wide into the stretch, gained command at mid stretch and drew clear driving. MARK MY DREAMS off slowly, was hustled along, pressed the pace, gained command on the backstretch, finished well but could not hold off the winner. VERNON INVADER never far back, saved ground most of the way, came off the rail into the final turn, rallied four wide through the stretch and also finished well. WINITALL away alertly, was well placed, made a middle move three wide, weakened through the stretch. POINT FIVE away alertly, assumed command, set pace, gave way on the backstretch when tiring. BRILLIANT IDEA never far back, three wide on the first turn, four wide around the second turn, weakened late.
