KANONKULE broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, gained the lead on the backstretch, drew clear on the second turn and won driving. OVERTIME MAGIC broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from the inside, rallied on the two path and was second best. YOLLA LAD away alertly and well placed, tracked the leaders from three wide, was outrun in the stretch. FLAMING SEVEN away alertly and well placed, tracked the leaders from off the rail, had no late move. ZEKES' BEST TRICK broke sharply, gained command and the rail, set a pressured pace, gave way. DUBA unhurried early, stalked the pace from three wide, failed to menace. I'M FAMOUS slow early, showed little and was not a threat. LAGER MAN three wide into the first turn, trailed for most of the trip and showed little. VIA COL VENTO unhurried early, stalked the pace from the inside, was never a threat.
