### Footnotes

SARTORIALIST unhurried early and trailed the field down the backstretch racing three wide, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, swung four wide into the stretch and was up in the final strides. MADEIRA PARK away alertly and dueled for the early lead racing three wide, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but was unable to hold off SARTORIALIST in the late stages. GREENWICH broke sharply and vied for the early lead racing one from the rail,battled to the inside of MADEIRA PARK around the final turn and faded slightly in deep stretch in a game effort. TON OF PRIDE stalked the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, held a striking position into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response. HELLO FRANKIE away well and tracked the early pacesetters into the first turn racing three wide, continued on from the outside down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
