Footnotes

RAISING MEMO unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush four wide in the stretch under left handed urging. CABO CHICO broke sharply, and vied for the lead racing one out from the rail entering the first turn, gain command through the turn, and controlled the pace down the backstretch,turned back a challenge from PRINCIPE'S HERBIE leaving the final turn, but was unable to hold off the late charge by RAISING MEMO, while proving clearly second best. PRINCIPE'S HERBIE away alertly, and dueled for the lead from the outside of CABO CHICO approaching the first turn, held a tracking position behind that rival in the run down the backstretch, engaged the leader entering the final turn, battled through the turn, but was outfinished in the stretch drive. MULL OVER away well, and stalked the leaders into the first turn racing along the inside, saved ground throughout while tracking the leader down the backside, rallied along the rail entering the final turn and loomed a danger through the turn, but flattened out in the stretch drive. LORD HENRY stalked the leaders into the first turn racing two from the rail, raced four wide down the backstretch while racing four wide, but weakened over the final furlong.
