Footnotes

TOMMY D' HORSEY was unhurried early while racing three wide, advanced from four wide on the second turn, responded to intermittent left hand urging and drew clear late. DOG ROCK allowed to settle early along the rail, angled out five wide into the turn and finished willingly. J J'S GYPSY stalked the pace while racing outside a rival, engaged the leaders on the backstretch on the far outside but showed no final kick in the drive and unseated his rider after the finish. MASS MAILING was away alertly to duel for the lead while racing along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. NO MORE DRAMA, never far back on the rail and showed no late response. TUTANEKAI lagged back early off the rail, was four wide on the second turn and only passed tired ones. GENTLEMAN BEN broke sharply, dueled for the lead between horses and tired after a half mile. STRONG REALITY stumped at the break, rushed to contention while racing three wide and stopped in the stretch.
