Footnotes

MAJESTIC MARK away well, and tracked the leaders one from the rail into the first turn, rallied four wide entering the final turn, took command entering the stretch, and held the closers safely at bay in deep stretch. NEVERABETTERCAUSE broke sharply, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, jumped shadows from along the rail soon after entering the backstretch, and dropped into a tracking position, rallied along the rail on the final turn, tipped one off the rail soon after entering the stretch, and closed willingly to get up for the place in the closing strides. DEVON WAY away alertly, and dueled for the lead from the outside of NEVERABETTERCAUSE entering the first turn, assumed a narrow advantage entering the backstretch while racing one from the rail, held a narrow lead through the final turn, but was outfinished in the stretch drive. BURNABY BARON tracked the leaders through the first turn racing two from the rail, advanced to press the pacesetter in the run down the backstretch, but tired in the late stages. DEADSET unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, advanced three wide soon after entering the backstretch, but needed more when called upon entering the final turn. HOLY CHEROOT checked early when in tight quarters, dropped back to trail entering the first turn, and showed little.
