RUMBA MUMBO broke sharply and vied for the early lead from along the rail, held the lead into the stretch and drew clear through the lane. QUIET TAP stalked the pacesetters down the backstretch while saving ground along the rail, tipped three wide entering the stretch but was unable to challenge the leader. SUKITORI unhurried early while settling well off the pacesetters, advanced from along the inside on the final turn and closed one from the rail through the lane. SURVIVANT raced one from the rail through the early stages, advanced from between rivals nearing the final turn, rallied four wide on the turn and into the stretch and finished evenly. HASTY REPLY away alertly and dueled for the early lead racing one from the rail, pressed the pace into the final turn but began to fade over the final furlong. GRIEVANCE away well and stalked the early leaders while racing just out from the rail, raced four wide down the backstretch, but weakened approaching the final turn. CANADIAN SPRINGS was unprepared at the start and got away very slowly and trailed throughout. Following the running of the race there was a stewards enquiry into the start of the race, in particular CANADIAN SPRINGS, After review, the stewards deemed that CANADIAN SPRINGS did not receive a fair start, and therefore ordered a full refund.
