Footnotes

HERBIE D away alertly and tracked the early pacesetter through the first turn and down the backside racing one from the rail, engaged TIME MACHINE entering the final turn, took command mid way through the turn and quickly drew clear. THREE WOOD unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied four wide entering the final turn and closed gamely three from the rail through the stretch to prove second best. STOLENOTIS broke sharply and stalked the early pace from along the inside entering the first time, rallied two wide through the final turn, and closed with interest in a solid effort. TIME MACHINE away well and rushed up along the inside to take command entering the first turn while racing just out from the rail, was collared by HERBIE D entering the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival entering the stretch and faded. SILLY FELLA allowed to settle off the early pace racing along the rail entering the first turn, rallied three wide through the final turn but needed more of a response in the stretch drive. HOCKLEY settled off the early leaders into the first turn, advanced three wide through the turn to take a stalking trip into the backstretch, but began to weaken approaching the final turn.
