Footnotes

QUEEN'S VICAR rushed up from the outside to take the lead entering the first turn, held a clear lead down the backstretch and was never seriously challenged while holding the closers at bay. WAILIN' JACK away alertly and chased the pacesetter throughout while racing one from the rail, was under a stern drive over the final furlong and was just able to hold on for the place. BLAME THE BUBBLY unhurried early while saving ground at the rail, rallied from along the rail entering the final turn, tipped three wide for the stretch drive and was gaining late. PRINCESSES RULE broke sharply and stalked the early pace one from the rail, loomed a threat mid way down the backstretch but hung in the late stages. GRANGALLO raced three wide into the stretch the first time, drifted out entering the second turn and continued to give the rider trouble entering the backstretch, and showed little. MADOC dwelt at the start to get away extremely slow, was always far back and never a factor. Following the running of the race there was a stewards enquiry into the start of the race, in particular MADOC. After review, the stewards deemed that all horses received a fair start and made no change.
