NORTHERN CAUSEWAY away alertly and vied for the early lead racing just out from the rail, held a narrow advantage through the stretch the first time while racing three wide, was engaged by COMMANDER entering the stretch but prevailed after a stretch long duel. COMMANDER pressed the early pace while racing four wide on the first turn, raced five wide through the stretch the first time tracking the pacesetters, rallied three wide on the final turn, collared NORTHERN CAUSEWAY entering the stretch but was unable to overtake that rival in a stretch long battle. ARRAIGNMENT away well and chased the early pacesetter while racing three wide on the first turn, pressed four wide through the stretch the first time, loomed a threat down the back. GOLDFIRE unhurried early while dropping back to trail,closed four wide through the stretch and finished with interest. JUMP UP AND KISSME squeezed at the start to get away slowly, raced one from the rail down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn but hung in the stretch. TLAQUEPAQUE tracked the early pacesetter from between rivals one from the rail, held a striking position throughout but faded in the late stages. PATZCUARO raced one from the rail throughout but failed to be a factor. STORMY CANUCK broke sharply and stalked the early pacesetter, was forced to steady when in tight entering the first turn, saved ground throughout but faded in the final furlong.
