BEARROCK N ROLL hustled along on the inside, chased the leaders, gained the lead from the rail on the second turn, drew clear driving. SLEW'S BOY broke sharply, close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied and held the place. SOLDIERS RETURN trailed for the first half mile, rallied from three wide, closed and finished well. WOOMBROOM EXPRESS broke sharply, assumed command, set a rapid pace from off the rail, gave way. GILDED OPPORTUNITY broke sharply and was well placed, tracked the leaders from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. RIBOLETTO away alertly and well placed, gaining from three wide, weakened after the half.
