KONA DAYBREAK unhurried early, gaining, rallied from five wide into the stretch, was up in the final strides, driving. ANNADU broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, gained the lead on the second turn, drew clear, gave way. THAT'S HOW WE ROLL broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, finished well. VINTAGE VINO unhurried early, gaining from off the rail, put in a mild rally from four wide and finished well. SARATOGA INTENTION away alertly, tracked the leaders from off the rail, three wide on the backstretch, put in a mild bid to gain a minor share. LA NORIA slow early, gaining on the inside, failed to menace. EMERALD CITY away alertly, tracked the leaders from off the rail, weakened in the stretch. AMY OH MY trailed for the first half mile, gaining from off the rail, failed to menace. BAKARI broke sharply, in the middle of the pack, was through early and dropped back. YOU AND THE WIND unhurried early, tracked the leaders from three wide, was through after the half. MIDNIGHT VICTRESS broke sharply, gained command, set a pressured pace, tired.
