PAYTON'S BEST away alertly, and raced to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, controlled the pace in the run down the backside while staying one off the rail, turned back a challenge from SHOTGUN RALPH approaching the final turn, and inched clear over the final furlong. STEVESTON LAD stalked the leaders into the first turn racing one from the rail, commenced his rally from along the rail entering the final turn, tipped off the rail entering the stretch and closed willingly two wide in the stretch to proved clearly second best. WHAT GOES AROUND away well, and tracked the pacesetter into the first turn racing along the inside, tipped four wide entering the final turn to commence his bid, but was unable to improve his position in the stretch drive while finishing four wide. SHOTGUN RALPH broke sharply and tracked the leader into the first turn racing two from the rail, loomed a danger while advancing to press the pace three wide into the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. REGAL LEGACY unhurried early, while dropping back to trail in the run to the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but needed more, as he lacked the closing response needed in the stretch drive.
