Footnotes

HIGH END MAN away alertly and tracked the pacesetter into the first turn racing one from the rail, continued to track THE GOV through the second turn and down the backside, rolled up to engage the leader entering the final turn, assumed command mid way through the turn and quickly drew clear. THE GOV broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the inside entering the first turn, continued to lead down the backside, but was collared by HIGH END MAN entering the final turn, was no match for that rival through the final furlong, but battled gamely to hold the place. WILLO KAT away well and stalked the early pace from along the rail through the stretch the first time, held a tracking position down the backside while continuing to save ground, rallied two wide through the final turn and closed well through the stretch to just miss the place. SHINTOISM stalked the leaders through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, rallied two wide through the final turn but was unable to make a serious impact in an even effort. DOUBLE IT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, was forced to steady when put in tight quarters along the rail entering the second turn, continued to trail down the backside and lacked any closing response. Following the running of this race the stewards conducted an inquiry into an incident entering the second turn. After review the stewards disqualified SHINTOISM from fourth and placed this horse fifth for causing interference to DOUBLE IT approaching the second turn.
