FULL POWER AHEAD allowed to settle well off the early leaders, raced three wide down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and was up in the final strides. COLONEL COURTNEY away alertly but allowed to take back and stalk the early pacesetters racing one from the rail, raced three wide down the backside holding a striking position,rallied three wide into the stretch to take command but was unable to hold off FULL POWER AHEAD in the final strides. GOOD BAD N UGLY saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, advanced along the inside on the final turn and finished well along the rail. NOW ACT away well and dueled for the early lead one from the rail,chased two wide down the backstretch but faded over the final furlong. LOGANDALE broke sharply and vied for the early lead from along the rail,opened a clear lead down the backstretch but weakened in the stretch. EPICUREAN shied away from a horse to her inside in the run away from the gate, raced one from the rail throughout and never menaced.
