SLEWPAST broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, rallied and gained the lead on the backstretch, drew off and won driving. MANDI TAMBI slow early, rallied from four wide on the second turn, finished well as second best. MS. SARAH VYE away alertly and allowed to settle, rallied from between horses on the second turn, finished well. HONKY TONK PAT trailed for the first half mile, rallied three wide on the second turn, got to the rail in the stretch, also finished well. DEVDRUDAN hustled along to be close up on the inside, chased the leaders, weakened in the stretch. AFTER THE KNIGHT away alertly and allowed to settle, stalked the pace, failed to menace. ON THE MANTLE broke sharply, gained command from the rail, set the pace, gave way on the backstretch. VIC'S SWEETY broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders, three wide on the backstretch, was through after a half. MONASHEE broke in the air, hustled along on a three wide trip, was through after a half.
