CLARISSE B stalked the early leaders racing three wide through the first turn and down the backside, rallied two from the rail into the final turn, assumed command entering the stretch and inched clear. FLAME A FEU broke sharply and tracked the leader from along the inside through the first turn, continued to track the pacesetter while saving ground as she rallied along the rail on the final turn and closed well to prove second best. DANNY'S CHANT away alertly and raced to the lead entering the first turn while just out from the rail, held the lead through the final turn, was unable to match strides with the winner entering the stretch and faded late. EL CIERVO unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced four wide through the first turn, rallied three wide into the final turn, but needed more of a closing response. SILVER STREET away well and tracked the early pacesetter through the first turn and into the final turn while racing one from the rail, but was outfinished over the final furlong. ACCEPTABLE HENNA stalked the leaders into the first turn racing one from the rail, dropped back to trail in the run down the backside and never threatened. FINALLA BLOSSOM allowed to settle through the early going racing one from the rail, rallied five wide through the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive.
