Footnotes

FLAMES ABLAZIN tracked the early leader through the stretch the first time while racing one from the rail, advanced three wide upon entering the backstretch to press the leader in the run to the final turn, assumed command leaving the turn and drew clear through the lane. MORRIE'S GLORY tracked the early leader from along the rail throughout, rallied along the inside on the final turn and closed willingly to prove clearly second best. MY SECRET

WEAPON broke sharply and raced to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, took a clear lead into the second turn, held a narrow advantage into the final turn, but faded in the stretch drive. MADDY JADE allowed to settle off the early leader through the first turn racing two from the rail, rallied four wide on the final turn and closed two wide through the stretch to finish on even terms with MY SECRET WEAPON. JUST LIKE EMMA stalked the early pace while racing three wide through the stretch the first time, continued down the backside from a striking position but faded over the final furlong. JOEY LA BAMBÀ was bumped at the start to get away slowly, raced wide throughout, while improving her position in the run down the backstretch. MAGIC THUNDER away well and stalked the early pace while racing one from the rail, but weakened in the late stages. HASTY REPLY away alertly, but was taken in hand and allowed to settle well back of the early leaders, saved ground throughout but failed to menace. EPIC ADVENTURE showed no early speed while lagging well back, raced one from the rail into the second turn and raced seven wide through the stretch, and was never a factor.
