### Footnotes

DOG ROCK broke sharply and rushed to the lead entering the first turn racing along the inside, held the lead down the backstretch racing one out from the rail, turned back a challenge from GREEN DUDE entering the final turn,and was all out to hold off BLAME THE BUBBLY in the final strides. BLAME THE BUBBLY allowed to settle off the early pacesetters while racing one from the rail, rallied three wide around the final turn,and closed strongly in deep stretch to just miss. DOOBIESGOTAGUN taken in hand early and allowed to drop back to trail the field, raced three wide down the backstretch, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and closed willingly through the stretch while five wide. GREEN DUDE away alertly and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing one from the rail,loomed up to engage DOG ROCK for the lead entering the final turn, but was unable to match strides with that rival over the final furlong. WESTERN FURY chased the early leader into the first turn while saving ground at the rail, but began to fade mid way down the backstretch.
