LOOKOUT DUBAI away well and chased the early leader into the first turn while saving ground at the rail, held a tracking position just behind VIMANO down the backstretch and around the final turn before tipping three wide into the stretch and wore down VIMANA in the final strides. VIMANA away alertly and rushed to a clear lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, held the lead into the stretch but was wore down in deep stretch. GYPSY MAGIC broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, continued to press VIMANA down the backside, was unable to keep up in the stretch drive in a game effort. EL AGUILA REAL bumped between rivals in the run away from the gate, chased three wide into the first turn and into the backstretch, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn, and finished evenly. MR. COOPER hesitated at the start to get away slowly, trailed the field into the backstretch, rallied three wide on the final turn and was gaining through the stretch. O'GEORGE saved ground throughout while racing at the rail, but failed to menace. OUT OF DODGE stalked the pacesetter while racing three wide down the backstretch, raced four wide entering the final turn, drifted extremely wide on the turn and was through.
