**Footnotes**

NONE OF THAT broke sharply and raced to an uncontested lead from along the rail entering the first turn, increased his lead in the run down the backside and was never challenged while being kept to task. CONCILIATION unhurried early while saving ground in the early going, commenced his bid from between rivals nearing the final turn, rallied four wide on the turn and closed four wide in the lane. RIO NOVO away well and chased the pacesetter into the first turn while racing at the rail, took a stalking position down the backside before tipping three wide entering the final turn, rallied on the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. FIVE BOLD RINGS away alertly and chased the pacesetter one from the rail into the first turn, began to lose touch with the leader approaching the final turn when unable to keep up. ROYAL KNOW HOW raced mid pack while along the inside, advanced along the rail nearing the final turn, and finished evenly. TIM BITS raced four wide into the first turn and down the backside, rallied six wide on the final turn, came together and bumped with SANTA FE LINE entering the stretch and improved his position from the far outside. SANTA FE LINE was steadied in the early run away from the gate when in tight at the rail, rallied four wide on the final turn, came together and bumped with TIM BITS entering the stretch and failed to be a factor. INDY RIVER raced three wide into the backstretch but showed little. FERGUS raced mid pack three wide into the backside but was through early. LUNAR SPRING chased the early pace three wide into the first turn, pressed three wide down the backside but weakened over the final furlong.
