NUJ NUJ WINK WINK away alertly and tracked the early leaders from along the rail, slipped through along the inside soon after entering the backstretch to challenge for the lead, battled from along the inside through the final turn, held a narrow advantage into the stretch and was all out to hold off PIGTAILS in deep stretch. PIGTAILS trailed into the first turn racing three wide, advanced four wide down the backstretch to hold a striking position, rallied three wide on the final turn and closed from the four path and just missed. AQUATIC away well and vied for the lead into the first turn racing one from the rail, battled from between rivals into the stretch and was outfinished in the lane in a game effort. MASS FLORA broke sharply and dueled for the early lead while racing three wide into the first turn, continued on from the outside and faded over the final furlong.
