JUMP TO IT broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, gained the lead on the second turn, prevailed driving. CONSPIRACY THEORY away alertly, tracked the leaders from off the rail, rallied from three wide and was second best. VYING FOR GLORY broke sharply, gained command and the rail, set a pressured pace, gave way. SOULSHINE BREW trailed for the first half mile, put in a mild bid from three wide, was outrun in the stretch. ROSES FOR BEN broke sharply, tracked the leaders from three wide, weakened after the half. ROYAL BANNER broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, was through after the half. WESTERLY WIND slow early, showed little and was not a factor. I'M FAMOUS off a step slow, hustled along from four wide, was through after half and dropped back.
