Footnotes

TALE OF THE BAT away alertly and raced to an uncontested lead entering the first turn racing just out from the rail, held a clear lead into the final turn and widened his advantage over the final furlong. I'MARAINBOWRIDER raced three wide into the first turn while allowed to settle early, rallied one from the rail into the final turn and closed four wide in the stretch to get up for the place. DUBA was carried five wide entering the first turn while racing mid pack, advanced three wide down the backside to gain a stalking position, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed up along the rail in the stretch drive. FLAMING SEVEN chased the early pacesetter while saving ground at the rail, but weakened over the final furlong. REGAL CORONA saved ground throughout while racing along the rail in what was an even effort. PAY DADDY saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, but failed to menace. RUNAWAY REGGIE broke sharply and chased the pace one from the rail into the first turn, continued to pursue TALE OF THE BAT down the backstretch but faded over the final furlong. UNDER THE HOOD away well and chased the leaders from just off the rail approaching the first turn, raced erratically when between rivals entering the turn and took to the outside, raced four wide entering the backstretch while continuing to give the rider problem, and was through soon after.
