CLEAR TO CANADA away alertly, gained command and the rail, led throughout, drew clear driving. CHARTERHILL unhurried early, gaining from off the rail, rallied from three wide and was second best. SILLY FELLA broke sharply, pressed the pace from three wide, weakened in the stretch. SIMPLY SAM broke sharply and was close up, chased the leaders from the inside, rallied and finished well. GRAND HUNTER unhurried early, gaining from off the rail, put in a mild bid to gain a minor share. TEQUISQUIAPAN broke sharply, pressed the pace from between horses, gave way. MOBIL SUPREME unhurried early, stalked the pace from off the rail, failed to menace. BERNIE THE BANDIT in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from the inside, failed to respond. LOCKSMITH in the middle of the pack, four wide on the first turn, was through after a half. MOSEL RIVER slow early, trailed and showed little.
