Footnotes

TODAY IS THE DAY dueled for the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, assumed command entering the backstretch while racing two from the rail, and increased her margin in the stretch drive. FLATTER YOU settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the first turn, advanced one from the rail entering the backstretch to gain a striking position, raced four wide in the run to the final turn, rallied smartly three from the rail through the turn to loom a danger entering the stretch, turned out to be no match for the winner, but proved clearly second best. BATTLEING BROOK broke sharply, but was taken up entering the first turn, when squeezed between rivals, held a stalking trip from along the inside entering the backstretch, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the drive. BUBBLY ON ICE away alertly, and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, assumed a tracking spot in the run down the backside while one from the rail, rallied two wide into the final turn, and closed willingly three wide in the lane. COPPER CITY tracked the leader through the first turn, while racing four wide from between rivals, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, and closed with interest from along the inside in the stretch drive. PORTRAY UR VISION was bumped at the start, and dropped back to trail, racing one from the rail into the first turn, began to edge a bit closer from along the inside mid way down the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, and closed six wide in the drive. LADY AT WAR away well, and tracked the leader down the backstretch racing one from the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. AMBER MOON ducked in at the start, to get away slowly, settled well off the early pace racing five wide into the first turn, raced three wide in the run down the backstretch, rallied five wide entering the final turn, and finished seven wide in the stretch drive. LITTLE BLOSSOM chased the leaders five wide into the first turn, raced six wide into the backstretch, but began to fade entering the final turn. JUBELIANI chased the pace six wide into the first turn, continued seven wide in the run down the backstretch, while racing greenly, and giving her rider trouble mid way to the final turn, and steadily dropped back over the final furlong.
