WITH COUNCIL unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced one from the rail upon entering the backstretch, rallied along the rail on the final turn, and split rivals in deep stretch to get up in time. PAKAL allowed to settle off the early pace racing three wide into the first turn, raced five wide in the run down the backside, rallied five wide on the final turn, and closed willingly through the stretch to just miss. SWISS GAME away well and vied for the lead from along the inside of ROYAL VICTOR entering the first turn, battled with that rival through the final turn and into the stretch and was only outfinished in the late going. ROYAL VICTOR broke sharply and dueled for the lead from the outside of SWISS GAME entering the first turn, battled with that rival to deep stretch before fading. LORD HENRY away alertly and stalked the early leaders while racing two from the rail into the backstretch, raced four wide to the final turn, but needed more in the late stages. OSCAR AWARD stalked the pace into the backside racing one from the rail, dropped back in the run to the final turn, rallied one from the rail through the turn before tipping six wide and finished with some late interest. THIS BREWS FOR YOU was bumped at the start, settled well off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail, but failed to menace. CANUCKS ROAR broke outward at the start, rushed up to track the dueling leaders from along the inside entering the first turn, continued to track three wide to the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong.
