BITE YOUR TONGUE settled at the back of the field entering the backstretch racing just out from the rail, advanced two wide mid way down the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn, and closed determinedly from along the rail to get up in the final strides. WHO'S DADDY IS DAT broke sharply, and raced to the lead entering the first turn, while racing one off the rail, controlled the pace throughout, and just failed to last in the closing strides. CLICK HERE away well, and tracked the leader into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed with interest three wide in the drive, in a solid effort. CONTACT MAN settled off the early pace racing four wide through the first turn, began to advance five wide mid way down the backstretch, rallied four wide entering the final turn, and finished three from the rail in the stretch, while unable to pose a serious threat. I WANT SECONDS away alertly, and tracked the leader into the backstretch while racing one from the rail, from between rivals, held a striking position into the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong. CROSBY'S GOLD tracked the leader into the first turn, while racing two from the rail, but began to drop back in the run down the backstretch, and had nothing left entering the final turn.
