EPICUREAN away well and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing three wide, battled for the lead down the backstretch from the inside of GOLDEN RATIO, assumed a clear lead upon entering the stretch and held. TWOBIT'N BILLIE away alertly and tracked the pacesetters from along the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and closed from along the rail in the stretch drive to get up for the place. GOLDEN RATIO chased the leaders into the first turn racing one out from the rail, quickly engaged the pacesetters upon entering the backside racing four wide, dueled from the outside of EPICUREAN through the final turn but weakened in the late stages. EMMITT'S GIRL unhurried early while trailing the field, rallied along the rail on the final turn, tipped five wide into the stretch and improved her position without ever threatening. BEAUTIFUL BREEZE broke sharply and led into the first turn racing one from the rail,lost command mid way down the backstretch and began to fade. QUICKENS settled off the early leaders racing three wide down the backstretch but failed to ever menace.
