Footnotes

SWISS ARROGANT away alertly and rushed to the lead entering the first turn racing one from the rail, held the lead throughout and was able to hold off a late bid from LOOKOUT DUBAI in the closing strides. LOOKOUT DUBAI away well and pressed the pace from the outside off SWISS ARROGANT entering the first turn, assumed a tracking position behind that rival entering the backstretch, rallied one from the rail through the final turn , and came up just short in the final strides. WARREN'S TONY R. allowed to settle off the early leaders racing three wide into the first turn, advanced four wide soon after entering the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn and improved his position while getting up for a share. A LASTING PEACE broke sharply and tracked the leaders into the backstretch while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn and finished two wide in the stretch while unable to threaten. ANNADU stalked the early pace racing one from the rail into the first turn, lacked the speed to keep in touch with the top pair in the run down the backside, and lacked the needed closing response. DICTATORSHIP settled off the early pace racing just out from the rail entering the first turn, dropped back to trail in the run down the backstretch and was never a factor.
