Footnotes

COURTROOM KISS rushed to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear lead in the run down the backstretch, and increased her advantage through the final furlong. TOUCHING PROMISE stalked the early leaders into the first turn racing two from the rail, dropped to the rail to commence her rally entering the final turn and closed willingly to prove clearly second best. CHEROKEE WINDSONG away well and tracked the early pace into the first turn while racing two from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn and closed two from the rail to get up for a share in the closing strides. ALWAYSREDONSUNDAY bobbed at the break but recovered quickly and tracked the leader into the first turn while racing one out from the rail, held a striking position through the final turn but faded in the stretch drive. MADAYA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced one from the rail in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide on the turn and improved her position while unable to threaten. MANU MANU broke sharply and stalked the early pace racing four wide into the first turn, rallied one from the rail through the final turn but hung in the stretch drive. POLEBOUND showed no early speed while lagging well back and racing four wide into the first turn, and closed four wide through the stretch while unable to menace. ACCEPTABLEMEMORIES stalked the leaders into the first turn while racing just out from the rail, rallied two wide through the final turn, but had little left for the drive. LAZARIA LASS allowed to settle well off the early leaders, dropped back in the run to the final turn, and had nothing to offer late. Following the running of this race there was a jockey's claim of foul. The rider of POLEBOUND lodged a claim of foul against the rider of MANU MANU for alleged interference leaving the gate. After review the stewards dismissed the claim of foul and made no change to the original order of finish.
