Footnotes

TRACKER broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter three wide into the first turn, engaged the leader one from the rail entering the final turn, quickly took command and drew clear. NORTH PACIFIC showed no early speed while lagging well back and saving ground through the first turn, rallied four wide into the final turn and closed five wide through the stretch to get up for the place. GO FOR GUINNESS away alertly and rushed to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, held the lead until tackled by TRACKER entering the final turn, and was outfinished in the late going. STONERIDGE GOLD stalked the early pace racing one from the rail into the first turn, advanced two wide mid way down the backstretch and into the final turn, and finished well in a solid effort. PAYTON'S BEST away well and raced mid pack two from the rail into the backstretch, rallied one from the rail into the final turn, and finished evenly. TIMELESS CASH was off a step slow and angled in to save ground approaching the first turn, trailed into the final turn, and was only able to muster a mild late bid. LORD HARLOW tracked the leaders into the backstretch from along the rail, but faded over the final furlong. BITE YOUR TONGUE was forced to steady briefly while racing between rivals in the early going, settled one off the rail into the backside, but weakened entering the final turn. DA CORSA unhurried early while dropping back to trail, and showed little.
