QUEEN'S VICAR tracked the early leaders racing three wide through the first turn, engaged the leader one from the rail entering the final turn, took command mid way through the turn and was able to hold DASHING DAISY safely at bay in deep stretch. DASHING DAISY settled off the early pace while racing one from the rail through the first turn, advanced into a stalking position from along the inside entering the second turn, rallied two wide through the final turn and was gaining four wide through the lane while proving easily second best. DEAREST PRINCESS away well and tracked the leaders through the first turn from along the rail, held a three wide stalking position in the run down the backside, and rallied three wide over the final turn. MAIDA VALE broke sharply and vied for the lead from along the rail into the first turn, assumed a tracking position from along the inside entering the second turn, but was unable to make any impact on the top pair over the final furlong as she began to fade. TRIPPED THE LIGHT unhurried early while dropping back to trail, mounted a mild bid one from the rail entering the final turn, and improved her position four wide through the lane while never a threat. UNDO IT settled off the leaders racing three wide into the backside, but failed to menace. LASTING SPICE away alertly and duelled for the lead one from the rail through the first turn, took command approaching the second turn, was collared by QUEEN'S VICAR entering the final turn, and weakened.
