OLAXSA in the middle of the pack, gaining, four wide on the backstretch, gained the lead on the final turn, drew off driving as much the best. VICTORY CLAP away alertly and close up, chased the leaders from off the rail, rallied from three wide, was second best but no match for the winner. SMART CALL broke sharply, allowed to settle, gaining from three wide, was outrun after three quarters. GOBAL WARMING broke sharply, pressed the pace from between horses, gained the lead on the backstretch, gave way. AMBRATO broke sharply, gained command and the rail, set a pressured pace, gave way. COUNTRY KID broke sharply, pressed the pace from three wide, was through after the half. GRAND HUNTER trailed for the first three quarters, showed little. THEGREATSUMOSKI broke sharply, dropped back and showed little.
