Footnotes

SUPER STEVE dueled one from the rail for the early lead, pressed the pace three wide from the outside of GUNS N GOLD down the backstretch, took command entering the final turn, and repelled challenges from both NORTHWAY and MARKETIZE through the final furlong to prevail. NORTHWAY stalked the early pace while racing four wide into the stretch the first time, engaged the leaders four wide entering the final turn, rallied five wide on the turn and battled gamely from the outside to come up just short. MARKETIZE broke sharply and tracked the early pacesetters while racing three wide, loomed a danger approaching the final turn as he ranged up three wide, rallied four wide on the final turn, and battled from between rivals in the stretch drive. GUNS N GOLD away well and rushed to the lead from along the rail, vied from the inside of SUPER STEVE entering the stretch the first time, ducked in and brushed the rail upon entering the stretch, dueled down the backstretch from along the inside but began to weaken nearing the final turn. SMARTY FAWCETT away alertly and stalked the pace while racing one from the rail, raced four wide into the final turn and faded. WINDY DAY unhurried early while trailing the field, raced one from the rail into the backstretch but failed to menace. GREAT PRINCE saved ground throughout while racing along the rail, but was never a factor.
