TARUE GRIT away well and chased the early pacesetter while one from the rail, pressed the pace from the outside of MATCHABULL down the backside, took command entering the final turn and opened a clear lead into the stretch but was all out to hold off a late charge from MINSTREL'S TIME. MINSTREL'S TIME broke sharply and tracked the early leaders one from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, and was gaining quickly in deep stretch to just miss. SILVER CITY SAM stalked the early leaders racing three wide into the second turn, held a striking position down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn and was gaining through the stretch drive. MATCHABULL away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, vied for the lead from the inside of TARUE GRIT down the backstretch, lost command entering the final turn, and faded in the late stages. TOO MUCH DIRT settled one from the rail well off the early leaders through the stretch the first time, advanced from along the inside into the second turn and down the backside, but failed to seriously threaten. PATZCUARO trailed through the early stages while racing three wide, and was never a factor. TAI SHAN unhurried early, saved ground throughout but failed to menace.
