ANDRELL allowed to settle off the early leaders through the first turn, began to advance four wide mid way down the backstretch, collared JACKMAN ROAD leaving the final turn, and prevailed after a stretch long battle with that for. JACKMAN ROAD away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a narrow advantage entering the final turn but was quickly collared by ANDRELL leaving the turn and battled gamely through the stretch only to be nipped in the final strides. HE WHO LAUGHS LAST tracked the dueling leaders one from the rail into the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn and held on for a share in an even effort. MR. SAANMAN broke sharply and tracked the leaders into the backside while saving ground at the rail, dropped back in the run to the final turn, rallied one from the rail through the turn and closed three wide in the stretch drive. ROMPON unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one from the rail entering the final turn and improved his position through the final furlong without ever threatening. BUENO'S LEGACY away well and dueled for the lead entering the first turn from the outside of JACKMAN ROAD, pressed that rival to the final turn before fading and drifting wide through the turn and into the lane. NELLY'S TRICK stalked the leaders into the backstretch racing three from the rail, advanced three wide soon after entering the backstretch, but began to weaken entering the final turn.
