OVERVALUED away well and raced to a narrow lead through the first turn while racing along the rail, battled down the backside and through the final turn from the inside of CLARESMIEZIE, took command in mid stretch and drew clear. CLARESMIEZIE broke sharply and pressed the pace into the first turn racing one from the rail, dueled for the lead from the outside of OVERVALUED down the backstretch and through the final turn, was unable to match strides with that rival in deep stretch and drifted out under left handed encouragement in mid stretch, and just lasted for the place. CRY CRY CRY stalked the dueling leaders down the backside racing two from the rail, rallied three wide into the final turn, steadied in mid stretch, and closed to just miss the place. RANDOM HIGHS unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied one from the rail on the final turn and closed two wide in the stretch, but was unable to pose a serious threat. MY BAILOUT away alertly and tracked the early pacesetters racing one from the rail into the backside, rallied two wide entering the final turn but faded in the late stages. TIERRA DEL FEUGO settled off the early pace racing four wide through the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but needed more of a closing response when called upon. BURNIN' BRITCHES stalked the early leaders from along the inside entering the first turn, broke down mid way down the backstretch and was pulled up and vanned off.
