A Grade III Scale Weight Stakes for Three Year Old Fillies. By subscription of \$200 to accompany the nomination due on Wednesday, August 24, 2005. \$1,250 to enter and \$1,250 to pass scratch time. With \$125,000 added and an additional \$25,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. All Hastings Entertainment Inc. purse money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Preference will be based on current year earnings as recorded by The Daily Racing Form at time of entry. In a case where horses have identical earnings, preference will be given to the Breeders' Cup eligible horse. Scale Weight: 121 lbs.

MONASHEE broke sharply, assumed command, set the early pace, taken back, stalked the leaders, rallied on the inside, gained the lead at the quarter pole, drew clear on the final turn and won driving. QUEENLEDO in the middle of the pack, stalked the pace from off the rail, rallied from four wide on the backstretch, finished well as second best. A CLASSIC LIFE away alertly and well placed from off the rail, gaining from four wide on the second turn, rallied from three wide on the final turn, weakened in the stretch. WIND SURF in the middle of the pack, gaining from off the rail, rallied into the stretch and finished well. AFTER THE KNIGHT slow early, stalked the pace from the inside, off the rail, made a bid from four wide and gained a minor share. REGAL PUSHER broke sharply, well placed, chased the leaders, weakened after three quarters. MISS RAINIER trailed for three quarters, put in a mild rally, failed to menace. VICKIES SONG slow early, stalked the pace, put in a mild bid and was outrun. GENTLE FLOW unhurried early, stalked the pace from three wide, failed to menace. AVENGING KAT broke sharply, pressed the pace, took over the lead at the half, set the pace, gave way after three quarters. SECRETS GALORE

slow early, showed little and was not a threat. VIRTUOUS LADY off slowly, rushed up from between horses, chased and pressed from three wide, was through after a half.
