Footnotes

THE PHENOM away alertly and raced to the lead entering the first turn racing three wide, vied one from the rail from the inside of AIRAFFAIR down the backside, opened a clear lead in deep stretch and was able to hold off a late charge from EL AGUILA REAL. EL AGUILA REAL saved ground entering the first turn while settling off the early leaders, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, tipped five wide for the drive and was gaing in deep stretch. AIRAFFAIR broke sharply and chased the early pacesetter into the first turn racing four wide, pressed the pace from the outside of THE PHENOM approaching the final turn but faded late in the stretch drive. OUTOFTHECLOUDS unhurried early while dropping back to trail, saved ground while racing along the rail, rallied from just off the rail on the final turn and closed from along the inside in the stretch. MAUPASSANT away well and tracked the early leaders one from the rail, held a striking position three wide nearing the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong. VYING FOR VICTORY raced three wide throughout and showed little.
