TERLANI broke sharply but was allowed to settle off the early leaders racing one from the rail, rallied two wide on the final turn, tipped four wide for the drive and took command in mid stretch and drew clear. PRINCESS RAINIER stalked the pacesetters racing four wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn, entered the stretch with a narrow lead but was outfinished by TERLANI. EBONY N ICE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, raced three wide into the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn and was gaining in the stretch while five wide. WE ARE ONE chased the early leader one from the rail into the backstretch, took a stalking position down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn but faded in the stretch drive. RANDOM HIGHS away alertly and stalked the early leader from along the rail, rallied along the inside but lacked the needed closing kick. VYING TY GRR allowed to settle while saving ground at the rail, rallied along the inside on the final turn, but was forced to steady while awaiting room at the rail entering the stretch, and was through thereafter. B. C. CAT away well and rushed to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, opened a clear lead in the run down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong.
