**Footnotes**

I'M BIG TROUBLE unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, commenced a rally three from the rail approaching the final turn, and closed four wide in the lane to be up in time. S R ROCKETMAN tracked the pacesetter two from the rail through the second turn, pressed the leader three wide in the run down the backstretch, took command entering the final turn, but was unable to hold of I'M BIG TROUBLE, while proving second best. I'M FAMOUS broke sharply, but was taken in hand and allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, was shuffled back to trail in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide into the turn, and tipped five wide soon after entering the stretch and closed willingly, while the rider lost hid whip in deep stretch. PATZCUARO settled off the early leaders racing three wide through the first turn, began to get closer entering the second turn while racing four wide, advanced four wide upon entering the backstretch to loom a danger, battled four wide through the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. BEDROOM BULLY settled off the early pace entering the first turn racing one from the rail, gained a stalking trip one from the rail as they approached the second turn, raced four wide in the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, but needed more when called upon entering the lane. OUR LAST CALL away alertly, and stalked the leaders through the stretch the first time, while saving ground along the inside, held a striking position to the final turn, before fading. STEPMOTHER'S BOY away well, and rushed to the lead one from the rail entering the first turn, battled with S R ROCKETMAN down the backstretch, but weakened over the final furlong.
