COWIE CREEK broke sharply, and sprinted to the lead from along the inside as they approached the turn, opened a clear lead entering the turn, and increased his advantage through the stretch. TWO PUMP away well, and chased the leader into the turn racing one from the rail, closed two wide in the stretch, and while no threat to the winner, proved clearly second best. LITTLE BROWN DERBY chased the leaders one from the rail into the turn, and closed four wide in the lane while finishing evenly. LADY OKA chased the leaders into the turn racing two from the rail, and closed three wide in the stretch, in an even effort. WISHING FOR SILVER chased from along the rail into the turn, while devoid of the early speed needed to contend, and closed one from the rail in the drive. C B KOSMO away alertly, but was unable to keep tabs on the leaders entering the turn while racing two from the rail, and closed four wide in the lane. AFOREFFORT raced one from the rail into the turn, while devoid of early speed, and finished five wide in the stretch drive. WIND HAMMER was bumped at the start, and squeezed between rivals, but showed little. CARSON CITY BROWN was slow into stride, and showed little.
