J J'S ORCHID away alertly and rushed to a clear lead entering the first turn racing just out from the rail, maintained a clear lead into the stretch and was never threatened. DELTA BOUQUET allowed to settle in the early stages while saving ground at the rail, advanced from along the inside mid way down the backstretch, rallied along the inside on the final turn and was up for the place while closing at the rail through the stretch drive. EPICUREAN tracked the early pace while racing three wide down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the final turn and closed five wide in the stretch to get up for a share. REMARKABLY FREE broke sharply and stalked the leaders into the backstretch while racing three wide, continued from the outside down the backstretch, and lacked the needed closing kick. TAMIS STORMTROOPER away well and chased the lone pacesetter three wide into the first turn and down the backside, but weakened over the final furlong. QUICKENS unhurried early while dropping back to trail, saved ground throughout but was only able to pass a tiring rival in the stretch drive. YUKARI showed no speed early lagging towards the rear of the field, raced three wide throughout and wasn't persevered with through the stretch.
