HURRY ON HOME unhurried early while dropping back to trail entering the first turn, began to advanced three wide mid way down the backside, rallied three wide on the final turn, took command entering the stretch and drew clear. DOG ROCK chased the early pacesetter from along the rail into the first turn, saved ground throughout, rallied along the inside to take a brief lead before entering the stretch but was no match for the winner while proving clearly second best. PATH TO HOME showed no speed early while lagging towards the back of the field, rallied three wide entering the final turn and improved his position through the final furlong without ever threatening the top pair. KENTUCKY CLIPPER chased the early pacesetter three wide into the first turn, continued on from the three path down the backside, rallied one from the rail on the final turn, loomed a threat entering the stretch but hung in the lane. QUILCHENA PARK broke sharply and rushed to a clear lead entering the first turn racing three wide, raced well out from the rail while maintaining the lead into the final turn, drifted very wide on the turn and continued to drift through the stretch while fading. HINOMARU stalked the early leaders racing one from the rail, but came up empty in the final furlong. OUT OF DODGE raced four wide into the first turn, and six wide down the backstretch and was never persevered with.
