Footnotes

I WANT TO DUST HER was squeezed soon after the start and dropped back to trail, rallied four wide entering the final turn, took command soon after straightening for home and inched clear. TEMPERED STEEL was carried five wide entering the first turn, assumed a stalking trip entering the backstretch racing three wide, engaged the leaders three wide entering the final turn, took command through the final turn but was no match when collared by I WANT TO DUST HER entering the stretch, but battled gamely through the lane to prove clearly second best. WILLAMETTE tracked the pacesetter three wide into the first turn, rallied three wide through the final turn, but was outfinished in the stretch drive in a solid effort. LIL MISS BEAN broke sharply and rushed four wide entering the first turn, pressed the pace one from the rail in the run down the backstretch, but weakened in the stretch drive. ACCEPTABLEMEMORIES settled off the early leaders while racing one from the rail into the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn and closed three wide through the lane. QUIT YER WINEING away alertly, but was forced to steady sharply when in tight quarters at the rail entering the first turn, advanced one from the rail mid way down the backside, but hung over the final furlong. LOCKET showed no speed while lagging well off the early pace racing four wide into the first turn, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but failed to menace. KIRI'S GAL away well and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, lost command entering the final turn and faded over the final furlong. REALLY SMOKIN tracked the leaders through the first turn racing one from the rail, but was through soon after entering the backstretch.
