FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By early subscription of \$200 to accompany the nomination by June 15, 2012. A sustaining payment of \$300 is due on August 10, 2012 and a final payment of \$500 is due on August 31, 2012 with an additional \$1,500 to enter and \$3,000 to start. A late penalty payment of \$10,000 in addition to entry and start fee may be made on September 5, 2012. \$200,000 guaranteed, with 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Field will be limited to 12 starters and this race will not be divided. Preference will be based on current year earnings as recorded by the Daily Racing Form at time of entry. SECOND CITY squeezed soon after the start and dropped back to trail through the first turn racing one from the rail, began to advanced three wide mid way down the backstretch, rallied four wide through the final turn, took command shortly upon entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. DEVIL IN DISGUISE stalked the pace from just off the rail through the stretch the first time, engaged the leaders five wide entering the final turn, and closed three wide through the stretch to get up for the place. HOIST broke sharply and dueled for the lead one from the rail through the second turn, raced just off the rail through the final turn, held a narrow advantage leaving the turn but was quickly tackled by SECOND CITY entering the stretch, was no match for that rival through the lane and faded slightly in deep stretch. TAYLORS DEAL raced mid pack from between rivals entering the first turn, advanced from along the inside down the backside, rallied two wide through the final turn but needed more in the late stages. WILO KAT raced mid pack into the first turn while racing three wide, settled off the leaders into the second turn, rallied along the rail entering the final turn, was forced to steady mid way through the turn when trapped behind a tiring rival and was shuffled back, slipped through along the rail entering the stretch and closed with a rush from along the rail through the lane. HIGH END MAN away well and tracked the leaders three wide through the second turn, engaged four wide entering the final turn, loomed a danger leaving the final turn, but hung in the stretch drive. QATAR'S PEARL was off a step floor, raced four wide into the first turn, advanced four wide entering the second turn to

assume a striking position, continued from the outside down the backstretch, loomed up five wide approaching the final turn, but checked sharply entering the turn and faded. D'HONORABLE ONE settled well off the early leaders into the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but failed to menace. THE GOV tracked the early pace from along the rail through the stretch the first time, engaged the leaders three wide entering the final turn, but weakened in the stretch drive. EL CAPONE settled well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but was never a factor. DOUGS BUDDY away alertly and vied for the lead from along the rail from the onset, battled into the final turn from the inside of HOIST, but weakened in the late stages.
